SWIMMING LESSON SCHEDULE

THE LESSONS AVAILABLE ARE LISTED BELOW:

PRESCHOOL (AGES 3 and up): One-on-One introduction to the water. Allows children to adjust to the water at their own pace. Parents must be in the water with their child.

LEVEL 1: Supported floating and kicking on front and back. Alternating arm action, water safety rules, personal safety and rescue.

LEVEL 2: Floating and kicking in front and back, rhythmic breathing, combined stroke on front and back, turning over, personal safety and rescue.

LEVEL 3: Fundamentals of elementary backstroke, jumping into deep water (supported), diving from the deck, treading water, personal safety and rescue.

LEVEL 4: Deep-water bobbing, diving, breaststroke and sidestroke, turns, front and back crawls, personal safety and rescue.

LEVEL 5: Alternating breathing, swimming underwater, butterfly, turns, diving, personal safety and rescue.

LEVEL 6: Approach and hurdle on diving board, surface dives, treading water, throwing rescues, personal safety and rescue.

Make Note – Swimming Lessons Run Monday – Thursday. Fridays are used for make-up days only if necessary.
